Association Rules and Regulations

(Revised January 2021)

The following Rules and Regulations have been adopted by the Norwich University Memorial Wall Association (the “Association”) on January 22, 2021. The purpose of the Rules and Regulations is to more clearly define the criteria for inclusion on the Wall, as described in the By-Laws of the Wall Association and to clarify the application process to better serve the alumni and friends of Norwich University.

The purpose of the Association is to commemorate the death of those alumni, faculty, staff, and friends of the University who have made a Significant Contribution to the University.

Significant Contributions are defined as:

- Sustained service within **University Volunteer Organizations**, typically a minimum of ten years, that has positively impacted the University; or
- Served the University as a Faculty or Staff member, typically a minimum of ten years, that has positively impacted the University; or
- Financial contributions, currently achieving the two-star level (\$100K) in the Partridge Society.

University Volunteer Organizations include but are not limited to:

- Board of Trustees
- Norwich University Alumni Association Board of Directors
- Partridge Society Board
- Board of Fellows
- Norwich University Cemetery Association
- Club Leadership
- Admissions Ambassadors
- Class Agents
- Other roles recognized by the University

The *Association Rules and Regulations* will define the minimum contribution necessary for inclusion on the wall. The contribution beginning October 1, 2017 is \$2500.

The application deadline will be no later than August 1, and the Memorial Wall Committee will meet on an “as needed” basis to review applications. Candidates will be notified of Committee decisions. The Committee retains all rights in its review, approval, or denial of applications.
