Norwich University, along with other Senior Military Colleges, recently landed a two-year, \$19.5 million grant to create a Defense Department Cyber Institute program.

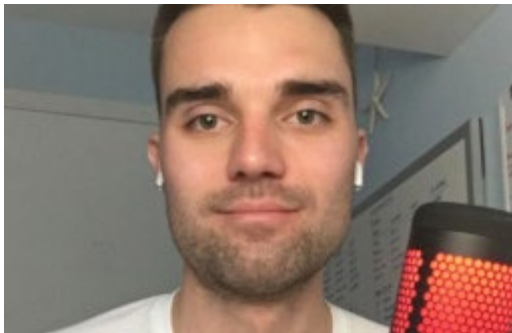

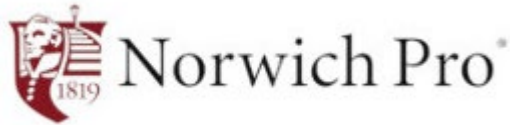

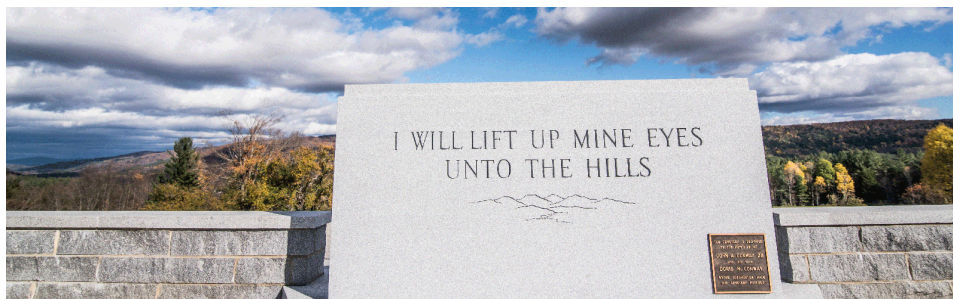
