Upcoming Certificate – Exorcising Hitler's Ghost: The Holocaust, Denial, & the Importance of History



The Holocaust remains one of the darkest chapters in human history. For historians, it has also become a target for lies, invention, and distortion from various malicious sources who have challenged its very existence. This course, "Exorcising Hitler's Ghost," will review the development of the Holocaust and the rise of Holocaust Denial. Our goals are two-fold. First, understand how and why historians have verified the reality and dynamics of the Nazi "final solution" and extermination plans for the Jews of Europe and other targets. Second, we

deconstruct how and why people deny the Holocaust and how they have profited from these distortions. By the end of this course, students will learn about the origins of the Holocaust and major debates surrounding its creation, the development of the Nazi extermination policies from words to deeds in war and peace, the emergence of Holocaust Denial as a post-war phenomenon, and how historians can challenge Holocaust denial with historical methods, evidence, and argument.

Instructor: Dr. **David J. Ulbrich** directs the online graduate programs in history at Norwich University. He is co-author of the 6th edition of *World War II: A Global History*.
